On-Site Health & Safety Procedure

Our #1 priority is the health and safety of our conference attendees, exhibitors, and staff supporting our programs. Every Total Health event will adhere to official government and local authority guidance, as well as any venue or location-specific regulations. We will continue to monitor the evolving situation and guidelines to ensure the highest safety standards for our attendees.

This includes and is not limited to:

- All Total Health employees supporting the conference will be vaccinated and/or fully recovered within the past 8 months
- Operating on the honor system, we will expect visitors to either have proof of a negative COVID-19 test, a completed COVID-19 vaccination, or documentation of recent recovery from COVID-19
- Hands free check-in experience to minimize touch points during the check-in process
- Programming floor plans will promote social distancing and spaced out seating
- Sanitation stations will be set up throughout the venue
- High traffic areas of the venue will be cleaned regularly
